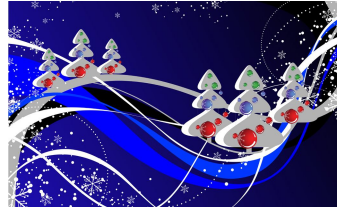

GOVERNING BOARD ACTION:

Approved Financial/Investment Statements: The Governing Board approved the Center's financial and investment statements for October 2009. It also accepted donations and gifts from individuals and agencies.

Approved Applications of School Bus Drivers: The Governing Board approved bus drivers for the 2009-2010 school year. The Board's endorsement is mandated by law for drivers employed by local districts.

Approved Organizational/Regular Meeting Date of Governing Board of Education 2010: The Governing Board approved Monday, January 4, 2010 at 5:00 p.m. for a combined Organizational/Regular meeting with the current President serving as President Pro Tem.

Appointed Career Center Board Members: The Governing Board appointed Carole Kuns to the EHOVE Career Center's Board of Education for a term beginning on January 1, 2010 through December 31, 2012.

Appointed Career Center Board Members: The Governing Board appointed Judith Sander to the Penta Career Center's Board of Education for a term beginning on January 1, 2010 through December 31, 2011.

Approved a Service Contract: The Governing Board approved a contract with P.T. Services Rehabilitation for therapy services for the 2009-10 school year. The contract states that P.T. Services will provide properly licensed therapists as requested by the Center.

Approved a Partnership Agreement: The Governing Board approved a partnership agreement with Marygrove College. The document provides that the Center will make area educators aware of continuing education online options available through Marygrove College. These include single graduate courses, as well as, a Master's Degree program (Masters in Teaching).
