GOVERNING BOARD ACTION:

Approved Financial/Investment Statements: The Governing Board approved the Center's financial and investment statements for August 2009. It also accepted donations and gifts from individuals and agencies.

Approved a Transportation Agreement: The Governing Board approved a transportation contract with Senior Enrichment Services (SES). The agreement provides that SES will transport students (in Center programs, as part of their educational plan) to and from job sites.

Adopted Special Education Policies and Procedures: The Governing Board adopted the *Ohio Operating Standards for Ohio Educational Agencies Serving Children with Disabilities*.

Approved a Memorandum: The Governing Board approved a "memorandum of understanding" from the Erie County Health Department requesting access to area high schools to conduct H1N1 inoculation should the need arise.

Approved a Proclamation: The Governing Board approved an American Education Week proclamation. November 9-15, 2009 has been designated as American Education Week. The Governing Board would like to thank Center employees for their contributions to the education of children in our area.

Approved Applications of School Bus Drivers: The Governing Board approved bus drivers for the 2008-2009 school year. The Board's endorsement is mandated by law for drivers employed by local districts.
