Description: Dr. Jodi Haney and her team will present Growth Mindset. Participants in this training will learn how to more effectively assist students reach their learning targets as students become fully engaged with course content. Growth mindset strategies are tried and true. Numerous research studies over the last two decades show that mindset strategies positively impact student attitudes, engagement, and ultimately achievement (<https://www.mindsetworks.com/science/>). Most importantly, mindset strategies help students go further with their learning, tracking more challenging material rather than choosing less difficult challenges because they feel helpless, or because they don't want to look "not smart." The outcome of this training is for teachers to learn Growth Mindset strategies, so they in turn, may teach students to embrace struggle, as struggle helps the brain grow.
