



OHIO SCHOOL COUNSELOR EVALUATION SYSTEM (OSCES)

The passage of House Bill 64 in July 2015 directed the State Board of Education to develop and adopt a standards-based state framework for evaluation of school counselors. The Ohio School Counselor Evaluation System (OSCES) was created in response to this mandate and is designed to assess the performance of Ohio school counselors.

In order to evaluate school counselors, the evaluator must complete one day of state training on the Ohio School Counselor Evaluation System (OSCES). The training will provide better understanding of the OSCES Framework and Model, and allow practice of skills and sharing of resources and best practices in educator evaluation.

A one day face-to-face training session is required for all evaluators of school counselors. *It is recommended that the evaluator and school counselor attend this face-to-face training session together.*
