X. Old Business for Information:

- a. PortfoliOH Jeff McClellan gave an update on the development of the new digital tool. Several districts in our region are participating in the pilot and providing feedback. He will be showcasing at the All School Summit scheduled for Oct. 10, 2023.
- b. Update on YouScience Implementation 25 school districts in the region are using the High School Discovery tool at the high school level. 12 schools are piloting the middle school Snapshot tool in grades 6-8.
- The first for the 2023-24 is scheduled: <u>All School Summit "Career Exploration in Action" Oct.</u>
 10, 2023 Registration is underway.
- XI. Committee Updates (provided by Economic Directors, Business & Education Partners):
 - a. Erie County update provided by Ed Kurt
 - i. Opening meeting for Erie County is scheduled for September 27, 2023
 - ii. Another successful Teacher Business Boot Camp was held in August. Twenty educators participated from 8 districts in the region. Participating business sites included: Firelands Health, Cedar Point, NASA Glenn Research Center, Kalahari Convention Center, Humanetics, and Freudenberg NOK
 - iii. Monthly meeting schedule for Erie County Steering committee has been established with a full partners meeting scheduled for March.
 - b. Huron County update provided by Ben Chaffee & Sarah Ross

- i. Quarterly meeting schedule for the new school year has been established. Will again hold the meetings at a local business site for a tour to follow the meeting
- ii. Ben noted a definite county level culture change with all schools embracing the need to focus on making career connections and expanding exposure activities
- iii. A Teacher Business Boot Camp 2.0 experience will be piloted in 2024 as requested by educators involved in the first three experiences
- iv. Chairman succession plan in place. Will Snyder will work with Ben Chaffee cooperatively for the first meeting and will assume the role of chairman for the remainder of the year
- c. Ottawa County update provided by Katherine Adams
 - i. Skilled Trades Academy has 28 enrolled. It is part of a new partnership with Vanguard as as a satellite program
 - ii. STNA has 16 enrolled for fall semester
 - iii. A new county level career connections roadmap has been created. Summer camps for younger students are being planned for 2024.
 - iv. A Teacher Business Boot Camp 2.0 experience will be piloted in 2024 as requested by educators involved in the first three experiences
 - v. The format of the Career Showcase has shifted. Audience will be high school juniors this year instead of freshman and the sites visited will be aligned to YouScience results
 - vi. Piloting a student business boot camp for 7th grade students from BCS
 - vii. 100% of the seniors at Danbury Local are in work-based learning experiences this year
- d. Sandusky County update provided by Kyleigh Lash
 - i. The bi-montly meeting schedule for the 2023-24 school year has been established and distributed.
 - ii. THINK Manufacturing day is scheduled for October 4, 2023 and will include all of the freshman students in the county.
 - iii. Three Student Business Boot Camps are already planned for this fall targeting Advanced Manufacturing, Finance and Healthcare industries
 - iv. Teacher Business Boot Camp 2.0 will be piloted for summer 2023

- a. Sarah Ross explained the Good Jobs Challenge which was awarded to Erie & Huron Counties. The basis is to target youth (recent & upcoming graduates) and implement the "work advance model." A partnership with BGSU Firelands was formed. The goal is to get 50 students identified to received an IRC and placed into internships in local counties. Students are being identified for participation based on YouScience aptitudes and interest.
- b. Alissa Fisher provided an introduction to the regional Youth Pitch Challenge 2024. The goal is to foster/encourage entrepreneurship. Involvement is open to any district in the region, specifically Erie & Huron counties. Interested teachers will use a curriculum provided by Young Entrepreneur Institute (YEI) and being with lessons in January. The regional PITCH Challenge is scheduled for March 21, 2024. An information meeting will be scheduled later in the fall.
