 - a. <u>Annual Joint Statement for 2021-22</u> Andrea Smith reported the Joint Statement was sent to the state by March 1, 2023 and posted on NPESC's website to be in compliance with all requirements. It was also sent to each superintendent to share with local boards of education.

 - a. Introduction of new Firelands Forward Director, David White

a. <u>Update on the current status of YouScience Implementation</u> - Andrea Smith shared the regional data being collected by county based on the Top 16 Career Clusters. Discussion was held on this data and implications for the BAC. Andrea also shared a view of the information each student receives after completing the assessment.

VII. Committee Reports:

- a. Erie County update was provided by co-chairman, Ed Kurt. A Full partnership meeting of the Erie Co BAC was held on February 24, 2022 at EHOVE Career Center. Over 60 partners attended this meeting to review annual goals and get a status update on the BAC. A Teacher Boot Camp is being held in August 2022 with 24 spaces available. Teacher applications are being selected. The Erie Co Steering Committee is actively trying to expand the data analysis with YouScience to plan activities and initiatives to best serve students. A data base to capture information on current seniors is being created in partnership with Firelands Forward and OSU. Expanding communications strategies have also been developed in partnership with Firelands Forward staff. The next steering committee meeting is scheduled for March 30, 2022.
- b. Huron County update was provided by Sarah Ross. The Steering Committee has recently held its third meeting since the pandemic caused a pause during 2020-21 school year. The Steering Committee is hold meetings in local companies this year with a tour to follow the meeting. The most recent meeting held on March 16, 2022 was at Borjer's Automotive. The first Teacher Business Boot Camp is scheduled for June 2022. Teacher applications are being accepted. The Steering Committee recently reviewed the county level YouScience data compiled by Andrea Smith. Ongoing conversations and data analysis will be conducted based on this critical data. A Senior Career Fair is being held on May 10 for all schools in the county at Norwalk High School.
- c. Ottawa County update was provided by Chris Singerling. A new employee with OCIC and OMJ Center (Ashley Spangler) has been able to go to three high schools in the county during English classes to do a career exploration activity and begin promotion of Skilled Trades Academy and new STNA Academy for next year's programs. A Teacher Business Boot Camp is scheduled for June 2022 and teacher applications are being accepted.
- d. Sandusky County update was provided by Andrea Smith. The third Teacher Business Boot Camp is being held in June 2022. Teacher applications are being accepted. The BAC is working to create videos highlighting "Young Employees of Business" to promote companies in Sandusky County.
